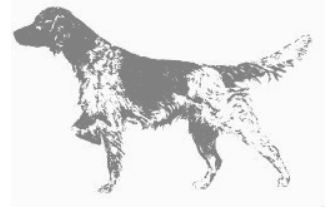

JUDGES CRITERIA

A1 List

For persons who have previously been approved by the Kennel Club to award CCs on the breed and have completed their first appointment. To have the support of the Large Munsterlander Club.

A2 List

For persons who fulfil all the requirements for the A3 list and who have been assessed in accordance with the Kennel Club requirements and accepted by the Kennel Club for inclusion on an A2 list and have the support of the Large Munsterlander Club.

A3 List (Breed Specialist)

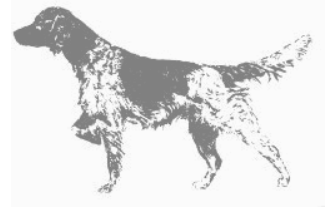
1. Minimum of 7 years judging experience in the breed and have the support of the Large Munsterlander Club.
2. To have 'hands on' judged 70 L.M.s.
3. To have attended at least one L.M.C. Breed Seminar, and passed an assessment where applicable.
4. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club accredited trainer, and passed the relevant examination on Kennel Club regulations and judging procedures.
5. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club accredited trainer on conformation and movement.
6. To have attended a conformation and movement 'hands-on assessment' conducted by a Kennel Club accredited trainer and passed the assessment.
7. To have bred and/or owned a minimum of three dogs when they obtained their 1st entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book (save in exceptional circumstances).
8. To have stewarded at 12 shows.

A3 List (Non Specialist)

1. Minimum of 7 years judging experience in any one breed (to include 5 years in this breed) and have the support of the Large Munsterlander Club.
2. To have 'hands on' judged 80 L.M.s plus 20 'hands on' other gundogs.
3. To have attended at least one L.M.C. Breed Seminar, and passed an assessment where applicable.
4. To have awarded C.C.s in at least one other breed.
5. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club accredited trainer, and passed the relevant examination on Kennel Club regulations and judging procedures.
6. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club accredited trainer on conformation and movement.
7. To have attended a conformation and movement 'hands-on assessment' conducted by a Kennel Club accredited trainer and passed the assessment.
8. To have bred and/or owned a minimum of three dogs when they obtained their 1st entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book (save in exceptional circumstances).
9. To have stewarded at 12 shows.

B List (Breed Specialist)

1. To have a minimum of 5 years experience in owning and exhibiting in this breed and have the support of the Large Munsterlander Club.
2. To have 'hands-on' judged 20 L.M.s.
3. To have attended at least one L.M.C. breed seminar, and passed an assessment where applicable.

B List (Non Specialist)

1. To have a minimum of 5 years judging experience in any one breed and 3 years judging experience in L.M.s and have the support of the Large Munsterlander Club.
2. To have 'hands-on' judged 20 L.M.s.
3. To have attended at least one L.M.C. breed seminar, and passed an assessment where applicable.

C List (Breed Specialist)

1. To own or have owned a Large Munsterlander.
2. Take an interest in the breed and have the support of the Large Munsterlander Club.

C List (Non Specialist)

1. Take an interest in the breed and have the support of the Large Munsterlander Club.

Club Shows [Open] (Breed Specialists)

1. Minimum of 5 years judging experience in the breed.
2. To have 'hands-on' judged 50 L.M.s.
3. To have attended at least one L.M.C. breed seminar.

Club Shows [Open] (Non Specialists)

1. Minimum of 5 years judging experience in the breed.
2. To have 'hands-on' judged 60 L.M.s and 20 'hands-on' other gundogs.
3. To have attended at least one L.M.C. breed seminar.

For Club Open Shows the criteria are guidelines for the committee.

All the above must obtain 50% of the vote at a L.M.C. Management Committee Meeting.
