PD (1) 1 Hargreaves' Ghyllbeck Monsignor, quality puppy with the best of head, & dark expressive eye, well placed shoulder in a balanced body with just the right amount of angulation. Super well boned legs & feet. Presented a good outline & moved soundly for 1 so young. Must have a promising future. **JD** (2,1a) 1 Carver's Crumpsbrook Basil, 12 month old & still very young & needing maturity. Pleasing head, good bone, well ribbed body. Needing to drop with maturity. Movement a little erratic. **PGD** (3,1) 1 Jenks' Kalabagh Lightning, masculine headed dog, with plenty bone & substance. OK neck & shoulder in a well ribbed body with adequate rear angulation. Moved OK; 2 Tordoff's Crumpsbrook Rather Gallant, immature in head, would like a little more strength in foreface. OK neck & shoulder, balanced outline, shown in good condition. Moved OK. **LD** (4,1) 1 Middleton's Raycris Quite Amazing von Zelawen, mature dog who presented a pleasing balanced outline, masculine head. Good bone, legs & feet, deep well ribbed body with plenty of rear angulation. Shown in good coat & condition. Moved with good drive in rear. **RCC**; 2 Murdoch's Celtaur Loch Glashan, pleasing type & balance, with a good head, well constructed body, needing a little more maturity. Moved with good side gait, would just like more strength in rear movement; 3 Taylor's Ichbin Jester of Tattay. **OD** (4,1) 1 Hewitt's Brockchime Be A Betta Boy, pleasing overall for type & balance, good head, well made body with plenty bone & substance. Well angulated in front & rear. Shown in good coat. Moved with reach & drive. **CC**; 2 O'Connell & Ogle's Ch Raycris Quite The Charmer, worthy champion for type & balance, would like a little more depth in forechest. Good head, well made body with good bone. Moved OK; 3 Macgregor's Jaudas Fame And Glory.

PB (1) 1 Stevens & Hargreaves' Ghyllbeck French Holly, another promising puppy bitch, litter sister to dog, I awarded both their parents a **CC** & see that they have inherited many of their qualities. **JB** (1) 1 James' Crumpsbrook Angelica, smaller framed bitch. Still needing to develop with maturity. Feminine head, pleasing outline & construction. Moved OK. **PGB** (6,1) 1 Hewitt's Brockchime Luna, lovely overall type & qualities. Presents a balanced outline with good reach & drive on the move. Good bone & substance, deep well ribbed body with good rear angulation. Shown in good coat & moved well. **RCC**; 2 Butler's Ichbin Jaunty of Jendella's, feminine bitch of a pleasing outline & type. Well made body with plenty bone & angulation both ends. Moved OK; 3 Tordoff's Crumpsbrook Rather Elegant. **LB** (4,1) 1 Horan's Fulaluv Awaited Arrival, pleasing type with a feminine head, good neck & shoulder in a deep well ribbed body with well angulated hindquarters. Presented a pleasing outline. Coat not at her best. Would like more strength in rear movement; 2 Reader's Kalimna April Fool, pleasing type, with good head, balanced body, just a little heavy over shoulder, good rear angulation, moved OK; 3 Leeming's Ashlowrick Ladies Day at Iscadu. **OB** (4) 1 Ogle &

Butler's Sh Ch Raycris Freya, quality bitch of lovely type & construction, from a feminine head through a mature balanced body to strong well made hindquarters. Shown in lovely coat, moved soundly with good side gait. CC & BOB; 2 Reader's Sh Ch Celtaur Atlantic Seal, lovely bitch with lots to like about her, well made, balanced & mature outline spoilt by too much coat & carrying excess weight. Moved OK; 3 Williamson's Celtaur Speckled Garnet.
