## EYE TESTING CLINIC June 20<sup>th</sup> 2021

Organised by the LMC at their Championship Show day on Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2021

The Large Munsterlander Club are holding an Eye Testing Clinic in conjunction with their two Championship Shows on Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2021.

Testing will be carried out by Paul McPherson from the Minster Veterinary Group at Southwell.

All fees for Large Munsterlanders will be heavily subsidised.

Dogs over 8 years FOC. Dogs under 8years £10.00.

By accepting this subsidy, owners agree that the Club/Paul McPherson may publish the results and use those results to build evidence about eye health in the breed.

### Appointments must be Pre booked

Your Munster must be either, entered in the show or entered "Not for Competition"

The owner does not have to be a member of the LMC but the dog must have a original KC registration document and any previous eye test certificates which must be handed over before testing (these will be returned)

Fee for Munsters between the age of 9 months and 8 years    £10 per dog (normal cost £60 inc. VAT)  
Fee for Munsters over 8 years    Free of Charge (normal cost £34 inc. VAT)

### ALL BOOKINGS MUST BE PREPAID

Please note: Dogs must have a functioning microchip and the dog's KC Registration Certificate must be present at the time of the test for the vet to confirm the test has been carried out.

Each dog will be allocated a specific time to arrive so that paperwork can be completed and drops can be administered approximately 20 minutes before the appointment for examination by the Vet.

**COVID BVA Eye Testing Protocol - Group Testing**

The following procedure is suggested to accommodate both the government and BVA guidelines  
*The highest risk of disease transmission is during close human – human contact. PPE can reduce this, however Paul is at particularly high risk during the examination – impractical to wear PPE. Therefore Val McP will restrain each dog for examination and return dog to owner. ( a face mask will be worn if coming close to owners)*

**Owners should wear a face covering to have drops applied to the dogs eyes and paperwork collected.**
