

## **Covid-19 — Conditions of Entry — important information, please read LMC Field Trial Season 2020/2021**

1. Entrants/competitors will accept and adhere to all health and safety protocols attached to the trial, in particular those Covid-19 related; as stipulated by the government, DEFRA, as advised by the Kennel Club and applied by the LMC.
2. Competitors should be aware that all communication will be undertaken electronically.
3. Competitors must provide their own face mask, gloves and hand sanitiser to use at appropriate times.
4. Competitors must provide their own food and drink for the day.
5. Any entrant who feels unwell, suspects they may be infectious, or learns that they have been in contact with a person that has developed symptoms of Covid-19 must immediately notify the FT Sec and withdraw from the trial.
6. The order of draw will be emailed out to each entrant. There will be no field trial cards on the day, all cards to be issued electronically in advance to competitors.
7. Competitors must provide their own running number for identification purposes. This does not have to be an armband, but must be clearly visible to the judge.
8. The contact details of competitors and any attendees will be collected and may be used by the NHS Test and Trace system should any Covid-19 infection be reported at or after the trial. These records will be kept for 21 days.
9. Competitors must not attend a field trial if they reside in an area covered by a lock down enforced by the Government.
10. Spectators — it is advised that spectators are not allowed. Only the handler of each dog will be permitted onto the trial ground. If a competitor has more than one dog running, an appointed individual, ideally from their own household must be willing to hold their additional dog. Other competitors should not be used for this purpose. Anyone travelling to the trial with a competitor will be asked to remain in their own vehicle and will not be permitted to spectate, but their details will be collected for Test and Trace purposes.
11. Only competing dogs or those fulfilling some official activity will be allowed onto the trial ground.
12. Upon arrival attendees will please park with sufficient space between each vehicle to allow social distancing to be maintained. All persons are to check in with the Chief Steward upon arrival and before exercising their dogs.
13. Competitors must, at all times, obey the Chief Steward, the Covid-19 Officer and the Red Flag Steward, and are required to be of good behaviour at all times facilitating the smooth running of the trial and consideration of the Host's property and interests.
14. Persons attending the trial do so at their own risk. The LMC accepts no liability whatsoever for injury to persons, property, or dogs, however occasioned.
