JD (2) 1 Gronow's Cazooska Lilys Gin Fizz. Very nice dog but difficult to assess as he decided he was not going to stand still. However, he moved ok with good hind movement. 2 Lane's Rokko Vom Florbach (Imp Deu). Decent head, neck and shoulders, straight topline and strong hindquarters.

YD (2) 1 Gronow's Cazooska Lilys Gin Fizz. 2 Lane's Rokko Vom Florbach (Imp Deu).

GD (1) 1 Gregory's Jaudas Let It Rock.

PGD (5, 1) 1 Carter's Kamaze Firecracker. Liked his head and expression, straight front, good depth of brisket, well angled front and rear, his front movement, however, was not as good as his rear. 2 James' Darkensky Prometheus JW. Masculine dog of good size, enough bone and muscle throughout, nicely balanced on the move. 3 Day's Waldo Vom Busshof Mit Alfriston (Imp Deu). **LD** (5, 1) 1 Ellis' Quilesta So Treasured. Strong masculine dog with good length of neck fitting into good shoulders, good musculature and well proportioned throughout. Deep chest with well sprung ribs. Balanced topline on the move, very good movement front and rear. RDCC. 2 Miller's Quilesta So Majestic Of Rock Fest. Good masculine head, length of neck and well laid shoulders, deep chest leading back to strong hindquarters, moved steadily round the ring. 3 Macgregor's Ekkolander Snowstorm.

OD (4, 1) 1 Day's Raycris Constantin At Alfriston. Very well constructed masculine dog, good head with dark eye, good length of neck, leading into well laid shoulders. Just right for bone, angulation and musculature. His movement was sound and accurate keeping a straight topline on the move. Pleased to award him the DCC and BOB. 2 Macgregor's Sh Ch Jaudas Fame And Glory. Another very sound, well balanced dog, liked his masculine head, neck and shoulders, nicely boned throughout, very good front and rear movement covering the ground soundly with ease. 3 Groom's Sh Ch Brockchime Comet Of Grunjagen.

SBD (1) 1 Carter's Kamaze Firecracker. Best SP.

MPB 1 Tordoff's Quilesta Simply Unique. Feminine 7 mth old bitch, moving very well for one so young, attractive head, good length of neck, straight front and well angled rear, enough bone and muscling throughout. BP.

PB (1) 1 Harding's Callixus Athena For Mallingdown. Dreadfully thin, should not be shown as she is.

JB (3) 1 England's Qualitil Sophies Sunlight (ai). Quite a nice young lady, good type with pleasing feminine head, good length of neck, enough bone and muscle, good length of neck, with well laid shoulders, decent angulation, strong rear movement keeping a straight topline. 2 Miller's Ekkolander Dark Russian. Similar remarks as first, but a tad loose on front movement, however she was well presented and had strong hind movement. 3 Harding's Callixus Athena For Mallingdown.

YB (1) 1 Ward's Braccpoint Song Of The Wind For Gemlorien. A very nice young lady standing on good legs and feet, well presented with good length of neck with correct shoulders, chest deep enough, well balanced rear, moved quite well round the ring.

GB (1) 1 Miller's Asterpoint Da Vinci Of Rockfest. Very pretty bitch, good shape and quality of bone, nice dark eye with feminine expression, well angled fore and aft, good shoulders and rear, well muscled quarters, moved very well keeping her topline straight and keeping her perfect outline, she was very well presented at all times. Should have a good future. I felt she really deserved the RBCC. **PGB** 1 Tordoff's Quilesta Just Elegant. Really typical in head, good length of neck leading into well laid shoulders, good spring of ribs, leading well back into a reasonably angled rear. Showed well and moved ok.

LB (3, 1) 1 O'Connell's Jaudas Look At Me JW. Well balanced throughout in overall shape and presentation, nicely moulded head with nice expression, strong lin, correct shoulders, good width of thigh with decent muscling and angulation, moved well. 2 Evans & Gray's Tarkanya Hippis Hibiscis. Another pretty one, pleasant bitch in good condition, enough angulation both front and

rear, well proportioned body with good length of ribs with decent bend of stifle, moved well round the ring.

OB (4) 1 O'Connell's Ft Ch Jaudas Heartbeat. I couldn't believe my ears when I gave this bitch the CC. Reason being she was made up to Ft Ch & Ch Jaudas Heartbeat. The first one in Munsters so I believe. I was told later there was one in 1928!. What a wonderful thing to happen to this lovely clever girl. I had no idea she was already a Ft Ch. Well done and congratulations to all concerned. It is the most wonderful thing to happen to anyone in dogs. BCC. 2 Tordoff's Crumpsbrook Rather Elegant. A bitch in really good condition. Typy head with kind expression and dark eye. Good muscletone throughout, especially the rear quarters. She is well balanced and looks good both standing and moving. 3 Robins' Destanli Jedda's Diamond.

VB (2) 1 Darby's Sh Ch Brockchime Besta Both To Incadar. This 7 yr old bitch moves with reach and drive. Good front assembly, forechest with good return of upper arm, nice proportions throughout with decent muscletone, presented well. BV. 2 Leeming's Ashlowrick Ladies Day At Iscadu. Another seven year plus, bitch, was presented in very good condition. Well turned out with correct body proportions, decent muscling and angulation, she has decent shoulder placement with strong rear, moved freely coming and going.
