That said, I was pleased with my winners, the presentation of all exhibits and the sportsmanship of the ringside.

PD 1 Logie & Braidwood's Albadhu Walk On The Wildside. 10 mths, nicely balanced and bodied for age. Good musculature and angulation, again ok for age. Super black head, dark eye and well proportioned. On the move was very positive for a baby. BP. 2 Waddington & Chick's Albadhu Walk Of Life. Another 10 mth litter mate to first, so similar remarks apply. Just as yet not quite the body or steadiness in movement as one but this will come with time. 3 Glazebrook & Glazebrook's Asterpoint Iceman.

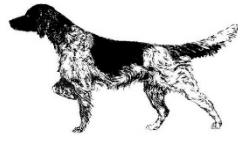
PGD 1 Jenks' Albadhu Hidden Potential. RCC. 2 yrs, of good make and shape. Liked his depth of chest and good topline, well muscled and angulated. Black head and good dark eye. On the move uses his hocks to provide drive and showed good front too. 2 Davis-Green's Abdecker Dancer. Another well made one with good topline, strong muscle and balanced angulation. Both of these were good on the move and could change places on another day. 3 Foreman, Foreman & Foreman's Toberworry Harvest Moon.

LD 1 Huggins & Davis' Tralala Chunky Monkey. 3 yr mature dog. Good well proportioned head, nice dark eye and well set ears. Good depth to chest, well muscled with strong loin and thigh. Angulation is balanced and movement is good with well used hocks and good front. 2 Dunsmore Jaudas Kind Of Magic At Kennedun. 4 yrs old, good head and eye. Nice topline and musculature. Angulation balanced, however, on the move showed good rear action but kept shaking his head which threw out his front action.

OD 1 MacGregor, MacGregor & MacGregor's Ekkdlander Snowstorm. Mature dog with good balance, topline and angulation. Nice musculature especially on the thighs. Well proportioned head, dark eye, and on the move looked easy with drive from his hocks and good front. 2 Goodley's Quilesta Just Talented. Close up to first in many aspects so same remarks apply just not quite as settled on the move today.

VD 1 Jenks' Kalabagh Lightning. DCC & BV. 8 yrs young and what a lovely dog. Super head and dark eye. Well set and used ears. Liked his overall build, good muscle and balance of angulation. On the move showed easy ground covering action with drive and reach, loved him.

PB 1 Arnold & Fleming's Asterpoint Maverick. 7 mths and what a nice one. Pretty head & expression, lovely dark eye. Very good outline and balanced for one so young. Moving was surprisingly steady and positive with good front and rear action. Very promising. PGB 1 Butler & Butler's Toberworry Breaking Dawn At Jendellas. CC & BOB. 2 yr old with pretty well proportioned head, good dark eye and well set ears. Good topline and well muscled. Balanced through so on the move showed reach and drive and lovely profile action too. 2 Ward's Braccopoint Song Of The Wind For Gemlorien. 3 yrs with many similarities to first. Pretty black head and expression, nice topline, well bodied and balanced angulation. On the move showed good action all round once settled. 3 Reed's Jaudas Miss Grace.

LB 1 Putnam's Asterpoint Faraday At Ebormist. 4 yr mature B. Good outline, well bodied. Good well proportioned head with good eye and ears. Angulation balanced and on the move has reach and drive from using her hocks, good front and covered the ground well. 2 Arnold & Fleming's Asterpoint Galileo. 4 yr old with nice outline, balance, muscletone and pretty head. On the move looked easy and ground covering. Just not quite as firm behind as first today.

OB 1 Logie & Braidwood's Cindy von Hundsfeld At Albadhu. Liked her overall make and shape, well bodied and balanced angulation. Nice depth to chest, also has pretty well proportioned head and dark eye. On the move well handled to get the best out of her, showing drive and reach as well as profile stride. 2 Robins & Robins' Sh Ch Destanli Jedda's Diamond. Another pleasing outline, head, muscletone and balance. On the move covered the ground well showing drive and reach. Just not as positive as first today. 3 Hewitt & Hewitt's Brockchime Frolicsome.

VB Two nice bitches here. 1 Darby & Darby's Sh Ch Brockchime Besta Both To Incadar. RCC. Smart make and shape. Very well muscled for nine and a half years. Angulation is well balanced so on the move reach and drive and good profile stride too. All this and a lovely well proportioned head too. 2 Kitchen & Kitchen's Crumpsbrook Rather Regal Von Elkemutt. 7 yrs and close up to first, so similar remarks apply just felt 1 was stronger in rear action today.
