Minor Puppy Dog (No entries)

Puppy Dog (1)

1st Powell & Murrell's Crumpsbrook Woodrush. Promising youngster with a well proportioned, masculine head. Sufficient angulation fore and aft. Good square outline. Lively mover, needs to settle.

Junior Dog (5)

1st James's Darkensky Prometheus. Well made dog of good bone and substance with decent forechest and depth of brisket. Pleasing in head, good neck and short in loin, Moved well.

2nd Gregory's Jaudas Let It Rock. Eye catching, well marked dog with a masculine head and expression. Good length of neck and lay of shoulder. Balanced outline, just needing to mature.

3rd Day's Waldo Vom Busshof Mit Alfriston (Imp) Another nicely marked dog, balanced in outline, just needs to fill out and mature.

Special Yearling Dog (3)

1st Draper's Quilesta Just Talented. Liked this young boy for his overall balance and clean outline. Well proportioned head, giving a kind, intelligent expression, good neck, short coupled, sufficient angulation. Enough depth for his age. Presented and moved well.

### Post Grad Dog (3)

1st Ellis's Quilesta So Treasured. Well made dog of good bone, substance and depth. Lovely masculine head of correction proportions Good angulation fore and aft, square in outline. Good muscle, strong back. Covered the ground with ease.

2nd Macgregor's Ekkolander Snowstorm. Attractively marked dog, well presented with good muscle. Well constructed with sufficient angulation. Just needs to develop and mature.

3rd Weare's Kamaze Revolution. Lighter built dog, Pleasing head with good neck, short in loin. Moderate angulation with sufficient bone for size. Moved ok.

### Limit Dog (4,2)

1st Disney & Whiting's Wonglepong Will's Faramir. Masculine, well developed dog with good bone and substance. Straight front, strong neck and good depth and well muscled hindquarters. Covered the ground well.

2nd Day's Raycris Constantin At Alfriston. Well constructed, giving a good outline with sufficient depth. Preferred the head and front movement of 1st

### Open Dog (5)

1st Macgregor's Sh Ch Jaudas Fame and Glory. Lovely masculine head, high set ears. Well arched, strong neck, leading to good lay of shoulder. Short coupled with a good topline, held on the move. Good bone and well developed, muscular hindquarters, enabling him to drive round the ring.

2nd Hewitt's Sh Ch Brockchime Be A Betta Boy. Another quality dog with good bone and plenty of substance. Lovely balanced head, masculine but kind expression. Strong in neck and topline. Not quite the drive when moving as 1st

3rd Groom's Brockchime Comet Of Grunjagen. Strong, masculine dog, good forechest and spring of ribs. Strong hindquarters, well muscled. Not settled moving.

### FT Dog (1)

1st Wood & Tapp's Raycris Lure Of The Quest At Teufelsmoor. A nicely constructed dog, with good bone. Lovely proportioned head with a kind eye. Good angles fore and aft. He belies his age, a real credit to his owners.

### WT Dog (2)

1st Lloyd & Smith's Crumpsbrook Bayleaf Von Rulander. Well constructed

dog giving a pleasing, balanced outline. Firm, strong topline with slight tuck up. Moderate bend of stifle and well muscled. Good, long striding movement.

2nd O'Connell's Ch Raycris Quite The Charmer. Lovely masculine head with a good eye. Plenty of bone and substance. Just preferred the balance and outline of 1. Moved freely.

Veteran Dog (1)

1st Middleton's Sh Ch Raycris Quite Amazing Von Zelawen Cdex Udex. Such a lovely, masculine boy of excellent type and size. Good bone, forechest and depth of brisket, well sprung ribcage with slight tuck up. Lovely head of correct proportions with a kind, intelligent expression. Good angles fore and aft, nothing overdone. It was a pleasure to watch him move round the ring on a free striding springy gait with good extension and drive. He scored in movement to take DCC, BIS, BVIS

Minor Puppy Bitch (0)

1st Ward's Braccpoint Song Of The Wind For Gemlorien. Promising 10 month old has good conformation, pleasing in size and bone, whilst maintaining her femininity. Good shoulder placement and bend of stifle. Good neck and topline. Gorgeous, well proportioned head. Moved well covering the ground with ease. Pleased to award her BPIS.

2nd Bargman's Crumpsbrook Molinia. Different in type and size to 1, but still a well made puppy. Good in neck and topline, giving a balanced outline. When settled, moved well.

Junior Bitch (7,4)

1st O'Connell's Jaudas Look At Me. A very well balanced young lady with good bone for size. Decent forechest and brisket. Pleasing topline, slight tuckup. Good croup. Well muscled, in good condition. Moved well.

2nd Price's Darkensky Milano. Well made youngster with good bone and balanced angles fore and aft. Lovely feminine head and good length to neck. Moved with an easy stride. Just needs to grow her coat.

3rd Fleming & Arnold's Asterpoint Galileo. Different in type to 1&2. Lightly marked bitch with a pleasing, feminine head. Good shoulder and ribbing, short in loin. Would just prefer a bit more width and depth. Another, who left her coat at home.

Special Yearling Bitch (6,3)

1st Prowse's Quilesta Just Endearing. Well made, attractively marked bitch with good bone. Straight front with sufficient width and depth of brisket. Moderate angulation, well set tail. Lovely head with a good eye. Moved ok.

2nd Patrick & Seamon's Ashlowrick Yngvi Episkey. Different, finer type to winner. Pleasing, feminine head with a good neck. Strong topline and moderate angulation. Just needing to mature and was a little unsettled.

3rd Price's D Milano

Grad Bitch (1)

1st Black's Seahaven Limited Edition. Nicely made bitch with sufficient bone and substance for her size. Good length of neck leading to a firm topline. Well made hindquarters with good muscle. Moved well with good reach and drive.

P Grad Bitch (6)

1st O'Connell's J Look At Me

2nd Ogle & Butler's Ursel Vom Ahler Esch At Raycris. B/W bitch of good size, with sufficient bone. Pleasing in head, strong, arched neck with a good body and outline. Short in loin with well muscled hindquarters. Just preferred the rear movement of 1.

3rd James' Crumpsbrook Angelica. Nicely marked bitch, in super coat and condition. Smaller framed than winner, balanced in outline and angulation. Attractive, feminine head. Moved well.

Limit Bitch (9,4)

1st Hewitt's Brockchime Frolicsome. Liked this well made bitch for her soundness and type. Good size with correct bone. Attractive, feminine head of correct proportions, strong neck, well laid shoulders, good spring of ribs. Good forechest and depth, with slight tuckup, short in loin. Moved soundly with purpose. RCC

2nd Kitchen's Crumpsbrook Rather Regal von Elkemutt. Nicely balanced, giving a clean, tidy outline. Good shaped head, lovely feminine expression. Moderate angulation and good musculature. Presented and moved well.

3rd Robin's Destanli Jedda's Diamond. Similar comments apply. Well made with good bone, good neck and shoulder with an attractive head. Strong hindquarters, moved soundly, but not quite the drive of 1&2.

#### Open Bitch (5)

1st Ellis' Sh Ch Raycris Callista JW. Eyecatching and in lovely coat and condition, this bitch has a clean outline, balanced angles front and rear with good bone and sufficient width and depth. Lovely head, strong neck and good topline. Good, free striding gait.

2nd Patrick & Seamon's Sh Ch Ashlowrick Amazing Grace JW. Another with good bone, forechest and depth of brisket. Short in loin with a slightly sloping croup and good tailset. Presented in good condition. Moved soundly

3rd Tordoff's Sh Ch Raycris Quite Unique At Crumpsbrook. A good class, this bitch has similar attributes, attractively marked with a lovely head and good neck. Good length and spring of ribcage. Again, a sound positive mover

#### FT Bitch (1)

1st O'Connell's Jaudas Heartbeat. Good sized bitch with a well proportioned head. Sufficient bone for size with adequate substance all round. Good length of neck, firm, strong back. Well muscled, hard condition. Moved with a free striding springy gait.

#### WT Bitch (1)

1st Ogle & Butler's Ch Raycris Freya JW. Have not judged this bitch since she was a puppy, I thought her to be promising then ! She has the desired bone and substance without being coarse and retaining her femininity. Excellent type and conformation throughout, presented in top condition. Sound on the move, covering the ground with a free stride. Pleased to award her BCC, RBIS.

Veteran Bitch (5,1)

1st Trowsdale's Sh Ch Raycris Special Quest JW. This bitch really belies her age at nearly 11 years young. Shown in good coat and condition. She is a good size with sufficient bone and substance. Lovely, well proportioned head with a slightly arched neck and a pleasing topline. She flowed round the ring with ease. A credit to her owner.

2nd Bargman's Crumpsbrook Acacia. A smaller bitch, not showing her 9 1/2 years. Lovely, feminine head, adequate forechest and depth, slight tuckup and balanced. Moderate angles fore and aft. Moved soundly.

3rd Black's Seahaven Borrowed Heaven. Nicely marked bitch of good type and in good condition. Balanced in outline. Well laid shoulder and turn of stifle. Feminine in head and expression. Moved soundly.
