VD (1) 1 Day's Raycris New Attraction At Alfriston. Very typey. Slightly rounded head, strong neck, firm topline, has depth, moved on a free, long stride.

PD (2, 1) 1 Groom's Brockchime Comet Of Grunjagen. Well grown young man. Loved his head, strong arched neck, good angles front and rear, good depth and spring of rib, plenty of bone, firm hindquarters. Moved on a free and sound stride. Happy disposition.

PGD (4, 1) 1 Taylor's Ichbin Jester Of Tattay. Upstanding dog who is full of himself, lovely head and dark eye, liked his shape, well laid shoulder, deep chest, good spring of rib leading to a firm loin, well muscled hindquarters, moved on a free and reachy stride, shown in excellent well furnished coat. 2 Day's Raycris Constantin At Alfriston. Lovely head and expression, plenty of substance, firm topline, shown in excellent coat and condition, would prefer more depth. 3 Mason's Ichbin Jedi Obi Wan.

LD (5, 1) 1 Hewitt's Brockchime Be A Betta Boy. Super dog, masculine head and dark eye, strong neck into well laid shoulders, deep chest, excellent bone and good rear end with well developed second thigh, should always be there or thereabouts. 2 MacGregor's Jaudas Fame And Glory. Balanced head and pleasing expression, well developed chest, good body properties, strong loin and firm hindquarters. Impressive on the move. 3 Wood & Tapp's Raycris Gabriel Of Teufelsmoor.

OD (5) 1 Dewar's Sh Ch Hanechdene Jack Daniels. Lovely 10 yr old dog who put on a sterling performance, lovely head and expression, muscular neck fitting into a well laid shoulder, well off for body and condition, firm hindquarters, moved out on an easy, powerful stride. CC and BOB. 2 O'Connell & Ogle's Raycris Quite The Charmer. Another very pleasing exhibit, slightly taller than first, very good head, well laid shoulders, good topline and rear assembly. Moved out on a ground covering easy stride. Res CC. 3 Lloyd's Ch Paddockridge Rulander.

PB (3) 1 Hewitt's Brockchime Luna. Super quality, lovely head, dark eye, slightly arched neck fitting into well laid shoulders, deep chest and well ribbed back, good rear angulation, well off for bone, loved her. BP. 2 Suchett-Kaye's Cazooska Pixie. Slightly finer than first, feminine head, good depth and feet, plenty of development to come, moved on an easy stride. 3 Griffiths, Rose & Griffiths' Crumpsbrook Rather Radiant.

PGB (3, 1) 1 Moo Raycris Cilla. Lovely conformation and type. Excellent head, good front and rear assembly, effortless movement. 2 Bargman's Crumpsbrook Jasmine. Smaller framed bitch, good head and expression, level topline, good width to thigh, stands on good legs and feet, not just as positive in hind movement as first.

LB (8) 1 Ellis' Raycris Calista. Res CC. Excellent quality, loved her type and positive movement and is well constructed all through, lovely head and expression, good angles front and rear, best of legs and feet, good size. 2 Darby's Brockchime Besta Both To Incadar. Super head and expression, strong neck, good shoulders, front and feet, held her topline on the move which was free and springy. 3 Crumpsbrook Acacia.

OB (3) 1 Ogle & Butler's Sh Ch Raycris Freya. Gave her the Res CC last time. Lovely typey bitch, excellent head and expression, strong arched neck, well laid shoulder and good return of upperarm, deep body and well muscled hindquarters, moved on a strong easy stride. CC. 2 Trowsdale's Sh Ch Raycris Special Quest. Super bitch who also impressed. She has an excellent front and correct angles, well off for body and condition, another who scored in movement. 3 Patrick & Seamon's Sh Ch Ashlowrick Satin Flower.

GCB (2, 1) 1 Griffiths' Jaudas Foxey Lady. Lovely head and expression, well bodied, tight feet, firm body and quarters, presented a pleasing picture.
