VD/B (3) 1 Logie's Franorst Paws For Eirinn. Very nice honest bitch, with gently sloping topline, has a good length of head, black in colour, a moderate stop and good expression from dark brown eyes, well placed. Has good neck and good width/depth of chest, pleasing bone, decent pasterns and good feet, has good shape to her body and is in beautiful condition, moved really well out moving those in this class with ease, using her tail to advantage. Best Bitch and BOB. 2 Gray & Evans' Franorst Tilly Crothie Jw JW. Thirteen and a half years of age. Amazing for age. Elegant feminine bitch, losing a little in body condition due to age, compared to winner. Has a head rather lean than broad compared to one, has good ear set, topline good on the move, has short back and good angle to croup, Has straight forelegs but could have slightly stronger front pasterns. Movement not as good as one. 3 Kirkwood & Thompson's Ir Ch Helydon Knockandhu At Sarcottah An Ch 09,10.

PD/B (1) 1 Logie & Braidwood's Afton Z Lesa Habruvky (Imp). Pleasing youngster developing nicely, but still very raw, moving really well. Good elongated head, broad, high set ears, has dark very expressive eyes, slightly arched neck and gently sloping topline. Lay of shoulder quite good and some forechest is a positive, but would like a little more upper arm angulation and tighter elbows. Has enough bone and tight feet. Will continue to develop in body and fill out and has a medium length of loin and good bend of stifle. A real happy girl. Best Puppy. Res Best Bitch.

PGD/B (3, 2) 1 Logie & Braidwood's Albadhu Rainbow Of Love. Solidly built, black and white bitch, nicely marked with broadish skull but in proportion to body, I would like a little more length of muzzle, has a decent neck length and good lay of shoulders, would like a little more upper arm angulation. Her body shape is quite good width, a short loin and very good bone. She tends to stand a little higher at the back end and could have a fraction more hind angulation and strength in hind quarters to advantage. She has very good bone and is very well handled. A little nervous when being gone over, but happy on the move using her tail well, superb presentation.

OD (2, 1) 1 Logie & Gray's Albadhu Paws For Perfection. A handsome male strongly built, with a good outline, very good head shape, moderate stop and good length to muzzle, good ear set and length, very good reach of neck, pleasing spring of ribs, rises a little over loin, would like a shade more hind angulation but with strong rear pasterns, drives off well and looks good in profile. In nice coat. Best Dog. Not quite as dark in eye as the best bitch in the challenge.
