Large Munsterlanders

PD (2) 1 Procter's Crumpsbrooke Larche, more mature than 2 with a pleasing head & high set broad ears, strong neck, & good lay of shoulder & straight forelegs. Short coupled & broad hips with well let down hocks. BP; 2 Hunter's Ekkolander Glenfiddich, just 6 months & very much a baby with not the body of 1. Movement was a bit erratic which would most probably be due to his age. I liked his expression & shoulder placement. **JD** (2) 1 Taylor's Ichbinn Jester of Tattay, flashy young dog with lots to like about him. Good strong neck with an excellent lay of shoulder, sloping back with a slight rise towards the croup. Feathering still has to come but his movement was sound & driving which gave him. RBD; 2 Hunter's Ekkolander Glenfiddich. **PGD** (2) 1 Carver's Crumpsbrook Hickory, darker coloured than junior winner with a well-proportioned skull, slightly rounded with medium sized dark eyes. Ribs well sprung, straight front legs & oval shaped feet. Moved well; 2 Rixon's Raycris Raphael at Rixbriar, have judged this dog before when he was a junior. Maturing well with a pleasing outline. Good depth of brisket & strong topline. Not as positive on the move as 1. **OD** (4,1a) 1 Hargreaves' Sh Ch Gyllbeck Rappax, 5 years old on the day & is fully mature. Absolutely thrilled to go over this boy as I have admired him from the ringside for a long time. He did not disappoint & I use him as a blueprint for this breed. Loved his expression, strong arched neck & well laid back shoulders. Firm topline & broad hips straight front legs & straight hocks with good hind angulation. Well padded arched feet moved with drive & purpose. In top condition & could not be denied. BOB; 2 Lloyd's Ch Paddockridge Rulander, lovely dog who was unlucky to meet 1 in this class. High set ears with the correct amount of feathering. Good shoulder placement & firm topline with a long dense straight coat. Well let down hocks. Deserves his title; 3 Legg's Raycris My Kinda Guy.

PB (1) 1 O'Connell's Joudas Heartbeat, pretty looking puppy with good overall body shape with a dark head, good length of back & moderate angulation. Did not move as well as the Puppy dog in the challenge. **JB** (2,1) 1 J Heartbeat. **PGB** (4) 1 Ellis' Raycris Calista, I gave this bitch BB & BIS at the club open show last year while still a junior, She is fulfilling her promise & will trouble the best when she is fully mature. Good head proportions with high set ears & strong neck. Good depth of brisket, correct tailset, well knuckled feet & long dense coat correct texture. Deserves her award today but unlucky to meet the dog for BOB; 2 Bergman's Crumpsbrook Jasmine, lighter in build than 1 & not as well feathered. Body of correct proportions with well sprung ribs Moved well; 3 Pilkington's Tarkanya Daisy Daydream of Baycross. **OB** (6,2) 1 Wilkins' Hanechdene Black Velvet, dark coloured bitch with good feathering slightly round skull & high set ears with good feathering on them. Good lay of shoulder & moderate angulation. Straight legs & well let down hocks tight oval shaped feet, moved with drive to beat another very nice bitch. RBB; 2 Hargreaves' Sh Ch Ghyllbeck Angelique, lovely bitch whose construction is sound but lacking coat today which cost her the class. Well-proportioned & moved with drive. Could change places on another day; 3 Bergman's Crumpsbrook Acacia.
