Large Munsterlanders

PD (2,1a) 1 Cravens' Fulaluv Bavarian Bouncer, lovely breed type to this 10 months youngster, very well developed with good depth & substance & well presented in a nicely conditioned black patched & ticked coat. Lovely head with broad skull, good expression from medium dark eyes, strong arched neck into topline with slight slope to well set tail. Good depth & width of chest & brisket, angled upper arm, good ribs & strength to loin & hindquarters. Lovely balance with strong legs & tight feet. Fitting his name well, once he was settled moved out with good reaching gait & was sound both ends, I believe this was his handler's first show, did very well & should have a great show career. BP. **PGD** (2) 1 Taylor's Ichbin Jester of Tattay, took the first place over his litter brother. Lovely true outline to this masculine patched & ticked nearly 2 years dog. Stronger broad skull, nice head, well developed with good expressive dark eyes, good length of arched neck, well laid shoulder into a nicely held sloping topline to tail well set on & carried. Well angulated front & width of chest, good deep brisket, good body substance & well ribbed, nice tuck & well muscled & developed rearquarters, coat in good order & presented nicely. Much sounder than his brother with excellent side stride; 2 Mason's Ichbin Jedi Obi Wan, is of a nice breed type, stood with a gentle slope to his topline & nice set on tail but disappointing to go over as he lacks in so much substance & depth. Lovely head shape, not the strength of his bother but nice eye shape & colour, enough neck to well laid shoulder. Lacking in depth of chest, brisket & body which is covered with a well presented patched & ticked coat. Enough strength to hindquarters although would like better return of stifle. Moves out well but with elbows exposed away from body throwing his front, sound behind. Tail carriage little high. **LD** (4,1) 1 Macgregor's Jaudas Fame And Glory, very impressive on the stance, of lovely breed type with overall balance, looked super with his dark saddle markings on a well presented & conditioned coat. Masculine well worked head, a fraction too much in stop, good eye shape & colour, lovely muscular arched neck, well laid shoulder & good strength to backline & well set on tail although carried just a little proud on the move. Excellent angles front & rear, well muscled, good width of chest & depth of brisket with nice body, best of ribs well back, short loin & slight tuck. Good stifle & let down hocks, nice straight boned legs & compact feet. Really positive sound mover with great stride & ground coverage. RCC; 2 Logie & Gray's Albadhu Paws For Perfection, very stylish breed type head, expression slightly spoilt by lightish eyes. Good neck length, well muscled & placed shoulder, backline inclined to dip slightly on the stance, tailset & carriage little high. Good width & depth to chest & brisket, nice front angulation, body of substance, beautifully presented coat with saddle markings, ribs well back, strong hindquarters, would have liked more return of stifle. Straight well boned legs & tight feet, moved well with drive & sound; 3 Murdoch's Celtaur Loch Glashan. **OD** (3,2) 1 Hargreaves' Sh Ch/Dutch Ch Ghyllbeck Rapax, not having seen this 5 years dog before it was nice to learn after awarding him the CC that he was such a big winner. It could be seen from his stance & ring presence even with just being the only one in the class he was something special. Masculine well proportioned & balanced handsome broad head, with dark medium eyes & ears lying flat. Medium arched muscled neck, clean fitting into well laid shoulders into a slight sloping backline to well set on & feathered tail carrying it a little happy. Correctly angulated front assembly with a good width to chest & deep brisket & a body with substance & depth, with well sprung ribs well back into short loin with slight tuck. Muscular

hindquarters, well turned stifle & let down hocks. Beautifully presented black saddle & ticked makings, nice feathering. Stands over the ground well on strong boned legs & pasterns with tight round feet, very stylish mover with good side stride & very sound both ends. CC, BOB & G3.

PB (4,2) 1 Logie & Braidwood's Afton Z Lesa Habruvky, very pretty dark head of strength, lovely breed type, expressive dark eyes, well held ears, arched neck of moderate length into clean shoulders, well laid into slight slope of backline to strong croup & well set tail, enough body depth, had the best width & depth of chest & front angulation. Ribs well sprung & back to a short loin, very well presented & conditioned patched & ticked jacket with little feathering coming. Needs more strength of bone, feet tight & compact, for her age was steady & sound but running a little close behind; 2 Suchett-Kaye's Cazooska Pixie, well presented coat with nice feathering on legs with saddle & ticked markings. 11 months & more developed & of good size & overall balance but for her age I would have liked more body depth & substance which showed in lack of chest & brisket depth. Not the front or rear angles of my winner, nice topline to tail. Pretty head of strength but would like less foreface, good length of neck. Well boned legs & compact feet, moved out with soundness once she settled into a stride. **JB** (1) 1 Logie & Braidwood's Albadhu Rainbow Of Love, very attractive & nice to go over, a fraction timid but stood her ground well. Broad feminine worked head of good proportions to her body, super eye shape with good colour & nice expression, neat ears well set. Strong medium neck, well laid back with good shoulder angles. Super front width & depth of chest, elbows in on the stance with depth to brisket but on the move is inclined to throw her front & runs wide but has a lovely reach & drive with excellent side stride. Holds a firm topline to tail, just a little proud on the move. Good deep body, nice tuck, well presented coat with nice saddle markings over a clean white with flecks. Well boned legs with tight feet. **PGB** (3) 1 Gray Stephens' Seahaven's Olympic Uthopia, on the stance these two bitches had lots of similarities & I see they are half sisters by Raycris Quest, I just preferred the slight stronger & well proportioned very feminine head, held well on strong muscled neck of correct length. Firm held backline with nice gentle slope to well set tail with nice feathering. Lovely musculature with depth & substance with ribs well sprung back into her loin, lovely angles with depth of chest & brisket. Muscular hindquarters with good return of stifle, well developed, nice straight well boned legs, strong pasterns & compact feet, very sound free stride; 2 Gray & Uherkovichova's Franorst Lady Pamela, good outline & breed type & of nice proportions, very feminine head, not the strength of foreface of 1. Good head carriage on a neck of strength, cleanly set into shoulders, a good length of back sloping gently down to well set & carried tail. Body needing a little more depth & substance, lovely saddle markings on a well conditioned coat with feathering. Good angles with strength, straight well boned legs, compact feet, very stylish mover with good stride; 3 Wheldon's Ichbin Kwanita. **LB** (4) 1 Williamson's Celtaur Lace Gown, beautiful well worked & proportioned solid head, nice skull shape, medium dark eyes with sweet expression, well set & hung ears. Strong medium neck, well laid back shoulder & a topline of strength with gradual slope to tail well carried. Presents a lovely outline on the stance with good body, depth, substance, well sprung ribs, short loin & a nice tuck-up. Dense coat, little short of feather but just enough to make a lovely picture. Best of angles both ends with good legs, pasterns & tight feet, stylish sound mover with great stride & drive. RCC; 2 Patrick & Seamons' Ashlowrick Amazing Grace, very attractive well proportioned with lovely feminine outline, presented in a clean white dense coat with nice patches & light tick markings, excellent dark head, well

shaped with sweet dark eye & nice expression. Lacked the depth of chest & not the forechest angles of my winner. Good sprung ribs, well back into short loin with nice tuck. Firm backline, well moulded croup with strength, good return of stifle. Nice straight well boned legs & tight compact feet, lacked the rear extension of my winner but was very sound both ends; 3 Leemings' Ashlowrick Ladies Day at Iscadu. **OB** (4) 1 Patrick & Seamons' Sh Ch Ashlowrick Satin Flower, beautiful breed type, presents a lovely picture on the stance, of good overall balance & is so well built & put together with a strikingly feminine well worked dark head, with expressive dark eyes, neat well hung ears, carries her head well on a muscular slightly arched neck, clean shoulders & strong slightly sloping back with nice furnished tail. Great body depth, well sprung ribs, nice bodyline & tuck-up, lovely muscletone & that right amount of weight, beautiful dense coat with a good texture & colour. Smart mover, correct angles, great legs & feet giving a strong action & so very sound. CC; 2 Hargreaves' Sh Ch/Dutch Ch Ghyllbeck Angelique, slightly more ranger in her build & make-up. Very feminine well worked head of strength & balance, eye shape is good colour, could be slightly darker. Strong medium neck, well laid back shoulder, back of good length, slight dip on stance but carried level on the move. Excellent angles front & rear, well muscled, good width of chest & lovely brisket, bodyline & tuck-up. Well ribbed back with lovely bodyweight, covered with a super textured coat with good feathering. Strong straight boned legs, good pasterns & tight feet. Super sound, good stride, very well handled by a young man; 3 Williamson's Celtaur Speckled Garnet.
