Could I just give a criticism? I was struggling with outlines today – too short necks accompanying too long loins.

**PD** (3) 1 Tordoff's Crumpsbrook Rather Gallant, would have liked more body, but is still young. Lovely colouring. Good shoulder lay. Moved well; 2 Lovelace's Crumpsbrook Rather Dashing, liked this one. Well bodied, level topline. Good stifles. Difficult to assess movement as needs more training; 3 Saynor's Ekkolander Miltonduff. **JD** (2) 1 Procter's Crumpsbrook Larche, lovely dog with good markings. Nice head, good depth of chest. Good in front & turn of stifle. Moved well; 2 Davis-Greens' Crumpsbrook Mispel, bit lightweight & very frisky. Level topline & good front. Couldn't assess movement. **PGD**(4) 1 Day's Raycris Constantin at Alfriston, really liked this strong dog with masculine colouring. Level topline, good front & rear, excellent conformation. Fine masculine head. Moved well. **RCC**; 2 Carver's Crumpsbrook Hickory, another nice one with good head. Would like a bit more body. Good front & rear assembly; 3 Lane's Ilko vom Florbach. **LD** (7) 1 James' Paddockridge Ortega, I like a strong dog but this one was a bit too much for me. Couldn't fault him in any other way. Level topline, good depth of chest, good front & rear assembly. Very lovely dog; 2 Middleton's Raycris Quite Amazing, this dog is deceiving, he is much stronger & better boned than he looks. Lovely head & good front & rear. Moved well; 3 Webb's Trumorlund Anthony. **OD** (4) 1 Dewar's Sh Ch Hanechdene Jack Daniels, my type, my colour, my head, just lovely. Perfect conformation. Moved well when he woke up but I am told he is 9 years old so can be forgiven. Good front & rear assembly. **CC** & **BOB**; 2 O'Connel & Ogle's Raycris Quite The Charmer, another smart one with good movement. Just preferred outline of 1. Good head & eye. Strong. Moved well.

**PB** (4) 1 Tordoff's Crumpsbrook Rather Elegant, lovely feminine bitch. Colouring & markings superb. Lovely head & good conformation. A champion in the making. Very steady for a baby. **RCC** & **BP**; 2 No name given, feminine one again. Good neck & shoulder, tad straight in stifle. Level topline. Needs more training; 3 Saynor's Ekkolander Tullibardine. **JB** (5) 1 O'Connel's Jaudas Heartbeat, strong bitch with good head. A little long but this may improve as she develops. Good mover; 2 Molyneux's Raycris Cita, good colouring, nice body. Front & rear assembly good. Just preferred head on 1; 3 Moo's Raycris Cilla. **PGB** (3) 1 Leeming's Ashlowrick Ladies Day, loved this one. Dark & gleaming, so well presented. Handler showed her so well. Feminine head. Neck & shoulder super. Level top & good angulations. Small but strong & muscled. **CC**; 2 Evans' Tarkanya Daisys Dormouse, strong bitch, white flecked. A little strong around the shoulder area. Nice head & eye. Good angulations. Moved a little wide in front; 3 Thomas' Ashlowrick My Fair Lady. **LB**(4) 1 Robins' Albadhu Talk To The Paw, striking bitch with good colouring. Headstrong so owner has difficulty controlling her. When under control, moved well. Lovely head. Good conformation, length of neck & good shoulder lay; 2 Ellis' Raycris Calista, bit stronger & not so good on front movement. Very strong for a bitch. Good neck, head & topline. Rear & front angulations good; 3 Bargman's Crumpsbrook Acacia. **OB** (5) 1 Wilkins & Butler's Raycris Carly's Quest, feminine but strong, b/w with good conformation. Good front & back assembly. Level top, deep chest. Front movement a bit loose; 2 Wilkins' Hanechdene Black

Velvet, smart dark bitch. Liked her a lot. Deep chest, level top. Dark, dark eyes. Good stifle, moved well; 3 Saynor's FT Ch Tarkanya A Spikeys Splendour.
