PD: (5/1).

1- Macgregor's Ekkolander Snowstorm: Nice puppy with a lot to like about him well put together lovely head and expression, well moulded head broad nose fine ears attractive outline good head carriage neck & shoulders has quality and substance in bone structure to limbs & feet excellent body and ribs for age, strong hindquarters & good tail carriage, moved soundly. **(PD & BPIS).**

2. Crowsley's Ekkolander Ray of Sunshine: Larger made boy, large built frame, masculine head fine ears and a strong jaw, good bite, kind eye. Pleasing in neck & front assembly, good depth of body, firm topline well developed rear with correct angulation tight feet just needs time to settle.

3. Connolly's Estarose Spruce: Another nice puppy, very pleasing head, lovely dark kind eye good bite, good head carriage neck & shoulders, well made body and ribs. Correct bone for frame tight feet good coat, moved okay once he settled into himself.

JD: (3/2).

1. Connolly's Estarose Spruce: Previous placed 3rd in puppy class, more settled in class especially his movement to take 1st junior dog.

GD: (1).

1. Miller's Quilesta So Majestic: Flashy 18month white/black neatly moulded head good eye set and expression well framed by fine leathers a good length of neck & shoulders, pleasing in chest & depth of body with level topline, correct length of back good strong hindquarters moved freely & soundly around the ring.

PGD: (1):

1. Lloyd's Crumpsbrook Bayleaf Von Rulander: Lovely masculine head dark expressive eyes fine leathers clean neck & shoulders, body in good depth firm in topline well developed rear with correct angulation tight feet moved out steadily, on the stack gave a balanced outline shown & presented in top condition.

LD: (4/1).

1. Siddons Fulaluv Beyond belief : lovely upstanding dog lovely head and expression good front and feet excellent bone and body good neck and shoulders lovely depth to ribcage & correct length of back strong hind quarters in lovely condition moved freely & soundly around the ring.

2. Day's Raycris Constantin at Alfriston : Lovely type again, quality throughout masculine head full of substance lovely outline clean neck & shoulders correct length of back lovely depth of ribcage firm topline and coupling, good tail carriage good coat condition with strong hindquarters, just preferred 1 on movement today.

3. Tordoff's Crumpsbrook Rather Gallant: Another quality dog throughout nice balanced outline very typy good neck and shoulders well developed rear with correct angulation tight feet moved out steadily unfortunately lost out on movement.

OD: (3). what a fabulous class.

1. Macgregor's Sh Ch Jaudas Fame and Glory: Lovely masculine head with good ears eye dark and showing kind expression, excellent front feet & neck strong muscular neck good shoulders correct length of back body of substance with well sprung ribs firm topline good strong hindquarters lovely coat & good hard condition moved out so well covering his ground with drive stood like a picture **(BD RBIS).**

2. O'Connell's Ch Raycris Quite the Charmer: Lovely head of quality good dark eye correct skull and

muzzle strong muscular neck good shoulders lovely body of substance front & rear angulation correct, super bone throughout moves out with drive, just preferred 1 on movement today. (RBD).

3. Middleton's Sh Ch Raycris Quite amazing Von Zelawen CDex UDex: Another nice example of top quality in this class, lovely head dark eye and showing kind expression, good breed type correct in neck and shoulders muscular rear with good angulation correct bone for frame, tight feet, pleasing ribcage and couplings overall balanced. Good coat moved well.

Spec WD: (3).

1. O'Connell's Ch Raycris Quite the Charmer: In this class I preferred this boy's movement: effortlessly-striding out, with plenty of drive.

2. Lloyd's Ch Paddockridge Rulander: 9 yr dog well put together in lovely hard condition correct length of back masculine head good bone and body, good coat good strong hind action. Lovely outline.

3. Kitchen's Tarkanya Bellas Bourbon Von Elkemutt: 7 yr old dog pleasing head dark eye dropping shoulders on profile front pasterns slightly down, good angulation in rear straight hocks, good tail set, just not showing off his best qualities today.

VD: (2).

1. Lloyd's Ch Paddockridge Rulander: Excellent outline good head carriage dark eye, well built body & ribs, muscular hindquarters still moving out soundly with drive. (BVIS).

2. Day's Sh Ch Raycris New Attraction at Alfriston: 11 yr old dog quality lovely masculine head with correct skull and muzzle good dark eye and expression neck & forehand angulation in good hard condition good length of back correct hind angulation straight hocks good tail set showing his age on movement a little wide in front.

PB: (1).

1. Smith's Dorro Vom Pfaffenbuck (Imp) : 9 month flashy girl Lovely head & sweet kind expression super dark eye good bite assembly body well made with good rib & topline correct in hindquarters pleasing bone for frame moved out well sound & true. (BPB).

JB: (2/1).

1. Vatcher's Kamaze Infusion: nice feminine head dark expressive kind eye, clean neck & shoulders good straight front lovely tight feet, body depth good and nice ribbing plenty of substance and bone, front and rear construction correct just slightly lacking in coat shown in good condition.

GB: (1).

1. Baker's Huttongall Lucy Loo : feminine headed bitch with well shaped skull soft expression and good dark eye front construction pleased with well formed body level in back good ribbing nice rearquarters tail well set & good carriage stood gave balanced outline moved out well.

PGB: (5/1).

1. Ogle's Ursel Vom Ahler Esch at Raycris: Flashy young bitch attractive feminine head good expression and dark eyes, strong jaw with good head carriage strong neck well sprung ribs and good depth of brisket good length of back nice rear quarters tail well set & good carriage stood giving a balance outline moved out well.

2. Baker's Huttongall Lucy Loo: Just preferred movement of winner.

3. James Crumpsbrook Angelica: Pretty bitch well made all through nice feminine head of good shape kind dark eye front and rear construction correct moderate angulation with little feathering pleasing expression moved quite steadily.

LB: (2).

1. Robins: Destanli Jedda's Diamond: with kind feminine expression broad skull and strong jaw strong, slightly arched neck running into well laid shoulders strong pastern topline slopes toward croup and a good depth of brisket with good tuck up well formed muscular rear plenty of bone moved out well with drive nice tight feet presented in top condition. (RBB).

2. Suchett-Kaye's: Cazooska Pixie at Settskaye. Another nice type of the breed lovely feminine head dark eye strong jaw good strong neck and front construction lovely body of depth level topline firm muscular hindquarters good tail carriage moved well.

OB: (2).

1. Tordoff: Sh Ch Raycris Quite unique at Crumpsbrook: Lovely feminine headed bitch super dark eye & kind expression good neck leading to correct front construction with good rib & topline correct in hindquarters pleasing bone for frame moved out well sound & true, nicely balanced presented in good coat & condition.

2. Darby's: Sh Ch Brockchime Besta Both to Incadar: Lovely type pleasing feminine head dark eye kind expression strong jaw good length of neck with correct shoulders good depth of chest with well sprung ribs firm back good rear quarters nice tight feet nice tail carriage moved well.

Spec WB: (2/1).

1. Ogle's Ch Raycris Freya JW: Got my attention as soon as she entered the ring good front and lovely feminine head dark eye with lovely expression fine leathers pleasing neck & well laid shoulders strong back & loin good couplings moderate angulation broad hips plenty of bone tight feet good strong hindquarters shown in beautiful hard condition straight coat with good feathering moving effortlessly around the ring. **(BB & BIS).**

VB: (2).

1. Ward's Incadar Illuminare for Gemlorien: 9 years in lovely condition lovely feminine head with kind expression lovely outline well boned good front, tight feet, neck & shoulders correct chest of good width good length of back strong hindquarters looked lovely on move.

2. Saban's Seahaven Bouquet of Roses: Nicely put together bitch feminine head with kind expression good outline with bone & substance dark brown eyes of medium size chest of good width firm strong back with short coupled loins well sprung ribs her movement was not as good as class winner but again quality throughout.
