I was disappointed with movement, some very close behind & a few wide in front. I have not said anything about coats as felt a lot were lacking, put it down to time of year.

VD & PD (0). JD (4,1a) 1 MacGregor's Ekkolander Snowstorm, just 12 months, head of a good shape, lovely eye, good forechest & depth, ribs well sprung & a good tuck up, correct topline & well angulated quarters, let down hocks, good feet, would have liked a lower tail carriage when moving, well presented, I see his sire was the DCC; 2 Saban's Estarose Reed, did not move as well as first, head balanced with a good eye shape, correct feet, deep in chest, good stifle & let down hocks; 3 Connolly's Estarose Spruce. YD (2) 1 E Reed; 2 E Spruce, would have liked better movement, had a good outline in body, good bone & shaped feet, sound quarters. PGD (3) 1 Lloyd & Smith's Crumpsbrook Bayleaf von Rulander, pleasing outline, lovely head, ears set high, medium tight eye, would have liked a better front, deep in body, topline flowed to well angulated quarters, moved well & handled; 2 Disney & Whiting's Wongleong Wills Faramir, I placed this dog because he was in tip top condition, as hard as nails, would like a better shoulder, has a good spring of rib & well let down, sound quarters, moved well; 3 Lovelace's Crumpsbrook Rather Dashing. LD (7) 1 Siddons' Fulaluv Beyond Belief, elongated head with high earset, good eye with a pleasing expression, good layback of shoulder, strong neck flowing into a correct topline & taut abdomen, well turned stifle & let down hocks, well presented; 2 Wood & Tapp's Raycris Gabriel of Teufelsmoor, good head shape & ear placement, correct feet, deep in brisket, good topline & tailset, well angulated quarters, not the front of first; 3 Stevens' Celtaur Lake Geneva. OD (5) 1 MacGregor's Sh Ch Jaudas Fame And Glory, lovely outline, head balanced & a dark eye, good forechest, ribs well sprung & deep with a good tuck up, strong arched neck flowed into a super topline & broad quarters with let down hocks, well handled & in good order. CC; Taylor's Sh Ch Ichbin Jester of Tattay, very close decision, just liked the front of first, also has a lovely head & eye, deep in body, has a good head & topline with strong angulated quarters, well presented. RCC; 3 O'Connell & Ogle's Ch Raycris Quite The Charmer.

VB (2) 1 Bargman's Crumpsbrook Acacia, this 8 year old is a credit to her owner, won on movement, good head, eye & forechest, deep in brisket, strong topline flowing into strong quarters & tailset, well presented. RCC; 2 Saban's Seahaven Bouquet Of Roses, 8 years, balanced head & pleasing expression, ears set high, good ribcage & depth of chest, strong quarters, not the movement of first. PB (1) 1 Patrick & Seamons' Ashlowrick Yngvi Episkey, 7 months, still has a long way to go, balanced head with good ears, pleasing topline, good quarters, moved out well. JB (0). YB (2) 1 Hewitt's Brockchime Frolicsome, won this class on maturity, head elongated with broad skull, good eye & earset, good legs & feet tight, correct topline & taut abdomen, strong quarters; 2 Trowsdale's Quilesta So Special at Cazooska, head still needs time, good reach of neck flowing into a pleasing topline & sound quarters with let down hocks, moved well. PGB (4) 1 Ogle & Butler's Ursel Vom Ahler Esch at Raycris, splitting hairs with these two, lovely balanced head, arched neck flowing into a good topline, tailset & quarters, chest deep, tight feet, presented in good order & moved out well; 2 Griffiths-Rose & Griffiths' Crumpsbrook Rather Radiant, I liked this bitch, she did not have the turn of stifle of first, good head & eye, deep in brisket, correct topline, straight front, in good order; 3 Bargman's Crumpsbrook Kerria. LB (5) 1 Butler's Ichbin Jaunty of Jendella's head balanced & of a good shape, pleasing eye, good front, medium neck flowed into the right topline with slight slope, good ribcage & deep, medium stifle; 2 Robins' Destanli Jemma's Diamond, lovely head & eye shape, good neck & topline, deep in chest & slight tuck up, not the front of first, good quarters with let down hocks; 3 Hewitt's Brockchime Luna. OB (1) 1 CC & BOB, Ogle & Butler's Ch Raycris Freya, this bitch has a lovely balanced head, medium dark eye, high set ears, good neck flowing into a good shoulder & topline, strong quarters, moved well, pleased to see her cut in the group.
