

# WKC CH SHOW, 21/08/15 - Large Munsterlanders

## Large Munsterlanders

I like the breed but I am sorry to say that the basic construction & movement in many of the exhibitors present & in the entry filled me with dismay – the breed anatomy is fairly standard & unexaggerated but the hindquarters & rear movement on many was very poor & forehands not much better. I hope the breed club & those in the breed, & I know how enthusiastic you are about the breed, will address this.

**VD** Best class in the males. 1 Raycris New Attraction at Alfriston, 10 years, at the lower limit of the size scale but beautifully made & the best mover in the class. Excellent ribs, short coupled. Quality head, carried himself well. Correct topline for the breed. At this stage I had no idea of what was to come & he was later a convincing CC winner, which made him up which delighted me; 2 Ch Paddockridge Rulander, 7 years, looked my winner standing for size & proportions & in lovely condition. Needed a little more chest. Couldn't match the winner moving at either end, but has type & quality & he was the RCC; 3 Sh Ch Doppelsoree Shady Geezer. **MPD** 1 Destani Jeada's Jade, 6 months, enjoying his first show. Has time in the head. At the moment a real gangly teenager & very uncoordinated on the move. He has good legs & colouring, I hope time will help him. **PD** 1 Ghyllbeck Monsienor, 8 months, well grown & lovely proportions. Excellent topline & quarters. Head needs time to finish, lovely eye. Good bone & chest. Excellent coat. BP. **JD** 1 Crumpsbrook Basil, 15 months, nicely bodied dog with good front. Can firm up a little in rear. Good head. Just a little throaty; 2 Crumpsbrook Bayleaf von Rolander, litter brother, I preferred his head but not the body or ribbing of winner or as good in rear action. Carries himself well; 3 Jawdas I Believe. **PGD** Very disappointing class. 1 Fulaluv Beyond Belief, 21 months, soundest dog in the class. His topline & croup could be better. Good head & eye; 2 Brookchime Comet of Grunjagen, 3 years, bigger dog with good head & outline although a little longer cast. Good head. His front & front action let him down; 3 Kalagbach Lightning. **LD** 1 Celtaur Loch Glashan, almost 4, smaller type needing a little more rib & body but won on stride & soundness, carries his topline well. Pressed in the challenge & has type, soundness & quality; 2 Ichbin Jester of Tattay, looked my winner standing, being more masculine & with better body but his action at both ends could be better. Strong & masculine; 3 Celtaur Lake Geneva. **OD** 1 Brockehime Be A Better Boy, 3 years, of good size & with a very good head, but needs more angulation, in good coat & with good ribcage.

**VB** 1 Tarkanya Lytas Lilac, 9 years, lovely bodied bitch with excellent head & lovely clean dentition, could use a little more rear angulation. On the day could have been firmer in front. **MPB** 1 Destanli Jedda's Diamond, 6 months, very promising in outline & proportions & a very good front. Can firm up in rear. Good head type. Shows a little haw in one eye. **PB** 1 Ghyllbeck French Holly, 9 months, well grown & with lovely head & eye. She needs more

angulation at both ends, good ribcage. Front action could be stronger. **JB** 1 Crumpsbrook Angelica, 15 months, at a real teenage stage but she has type & quality with a very good head & eye. A little close in rear action, in excellent condition. **PGB** 1 Brockchime Luna, 20 months, easy winner & at last a bitch with some width in the rear. I'd prefer her a little more feminine in head. Good body. A touch wide in front action; 2 Ichbin Jaunty of Jendella's, 2 years, lovely head, eyes & body, good in front but needs more confidence & just doesn't use her hocks well or carry body well. A pity; 3 Crumpsbrook Rather Radiant. **LB** 1 Kalimna April Fool, 4 years, lovely bitch with good movement albeit slightly close behind, excellent front, ribbing, head & eye. In excellent condition, good topline; 2 Javdas Foxy Lady, on a larger scale but I liked her a lot for type & quality. A touch wide in front. Excellent ribcage. Just lost her topline a little which she does with her runner but she has a good stride; 3 Brockchime Besta Both to Incader. **OB** Best class of the day – depth of quality & any of the top 3 could have topped the entry. 1 Ch Raycris Freya, lovely proportions, excellent movement. Could have a darker eye but everything else to please. Excellent ribcage & short coupling; 2 Sh Ch/Int Ch Ghyllbeck Angelique, lovely proportions & leg length. Like the winner could have a darker eye. Lovely ribs. Could be a little firmer behind. Pressed hard by 3 but I just preferred her balance; 3 Sh Ch Ashlowrick Satin Flower.
